- Communication with artists on visual content RehApp
- Providing critical insight in technical (medical/occupational) content
- Ensure consistency between the chapters
- Providing structure for the content by applying the ICF framework
- Communication with involved NGOs and App developer
- Monitor and evaluate the use of the RehApp

Essential skills and experience

- At least 3 years of experience in project management
- Excellent English writing skills
- Excellent English communication skills
- Work experience in low-income and/or middle-income countries is an additional advantage.
